### Ambulances <u>not</u> transporting a patient <u>to</u> an ED room:

Direct admits to any floor/unit, all discharges, clinics, lab, radiology, wound care, etc.

**Short-term parking (30 minutes max) is available at the Surgical and Heart Ctr in left traffic lane** for ambulances that are not transporting a patient to an ED room. The ambulance crew, if asked, should provide a phone number (e.g. dispatch center, cell phone, etc) for use in an emergency. Crews expecting to be longer than 30 minutes should use other designated parking areas including:

- Ambulance-only parking in front of <u>340 E Town St;</u>
- Ambulance-only parking on <u>E Chapel St</u> adjacent to the 285 E State St, Wilkins Bldg;
- Ambulance-only parking on <u>E State St</u> adjacent to the hospital main entrance;
- Loading zone at <u>141 S 6<sup>th</sup> St</u>, Blue Garage (Across from Surgical and Heart Center);
- Loading zone at 285 E State St, Wilkins Building (Across from ED entrance); and
- Loading zone in front of 323 E Town St, Grant Bone and Joint Center

There is no ambulance stopping at the main hospital entrance (State St and Grant Ave) at any time.



#### Wheelchair Vans, Ambulettes, Etc:

May actively unload/load at main hospital, Bone and Joint Ctr or Surgical and Heart Ctr entrances. Must move immediately after the patient is unloaded/loaded. Please do not stand in these areas at any time. Wheelchair vans, ambulettes, etc should never stop in ambulance-only areas or the ED circle driveway at any time.



#### **Lifeline of Ohio (LOOP) Organ Procurement Teams:**

**Should park in the designated Surgical and Heart Center (SHC) ambulance lane**. If no parking is available, may park in the ED ambulance bay. Please park straight ahead at the far end of the open area, when possible. This leaves the bays closest to the ambulance entrance available for incoming Emergency Dept patients.



## Police, Sheriff, Highway Patrol, Law Enforcement:

**Should use street parking** or park in an on-campus hospital garage. To exit for free, contact attendant via the call box in the exit lane. **Please do not park in the ambulance bays or in the ambulance lane of the Surgical and Heart Center.** These areas should be available for ambulance patients 24 hours/day.



#### **Public Parking, Deliveries, Etc:**

**Public parking** (Garages, meters, surface lots, etc.) and **Designated Loading Zones** are also available on and adjacent to the hospital campus. Please do not park or stand in any designated ambulance-only areas.

To Prevent Exhaust from Entering the Hospital, Please Turn Off Engine!
