## **EMS Education Application Requirements**

### **General Admission Requirements for all Classes:**

- \$10.00 application fee, \$20.00 for Paramedic (no personal checks or cash)
- Valid Ohio driver's license
- High school diploma or GED certificate
- Pass BCI criminal background check
- Not be in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 4765-8-01 paragraphs (A)(6) to (A)(12)
- Complete an interview with the program coordinator or lead instructor
- Laptop computer that is compatible with MyBradyLab

### **Additional Post-Admission Requirements:**

- Physical exam within the past twelve months, or complete prior to entering classes

### **Additional EMT Requirements:**

- Be at least 18 years of age or a high school student that is 17 years of age and in 12<sup>th</sup> grade in a secondary school, must turn 18 years of age before clinicals start

### **Additional EMT Refresher Requirements:**

- Hold a current State EMT certification that must be current through the end of the class.
- Provide proof of IS100 and IS700
- Optional - Laptop computer that is compatible with MyBradyLab

### **Additional Paramedic Requirements:**

- Successfully pass pre-admission testing
- Hold a current State EMT certification that must be current through the end of the class.
- Provide proof of IS100 and IS700

### **All applicants should possess:**

- Sufficient visual acuity for the observation necessary for patient assessment and emergency care.
- Sufficient auditory perception to receive verbal communication from patients and members of the health team and to assess health needs of people.
- Sufficient gross and fine motor coordination to respond promptly and to implement the skills including manipulation of equipment required in meeting health needs.
- Sufficient communication skills (speech, reading, writing) to interact with individuals and to communicate their needs promptly and effectively as may be necessary in the individual's interest.
- Sufficient intellectual and emotional functions to plan and implement care for individuals.
